Vendor Information and Application Form

- We accept three vendor categories-
 - Priority will be given to **craft vendors** selling items that are handmade. This can include arts and crafts, jewelry, clothing, household items, fine art, home-crafted food items to be consumed later, dolls and stuffed animals that are made by the seller. We have space for up to 60 craft vendors.
 - **Vendors of manufactured and mass-produced items and commercial services** will be limited to a total of 20 spaces.
 - **Non-profit organizations and community groups** will be limited to 15 spaces. Political parties and political candidates or their representatives may not reserve a space.
- Booth spaces are approximately 12' wide by 15' deep.
- Vendors will be assigned spaces by Plainfield Friends. **Indicate a preferred location** on the map included with the application. We will try to place you there but cannot guarantee a specific spot.
- Vendors must supply their own tables and chairs. Electricity is available on part of the grounds (100' extension cord suggested). Indicate on the map if you need electricity.
- We reserve the right to refuse any vendor whose product or presentation conflicts with our values and beliefs.
- No ready-to-eat food or beverages are to be sold on the grounds except by Plainfield Friends Meeting. This includes bake sale items. (Food designed to be prepared and consumed later, such as cookie mix or spice packets, may be sold)
- The Festival will be held rain or shine. No refunds.
- The cost of each booth space is \$35.00 if registered by September 18, 2017.
- Registration after September 18 will be \$45.00.

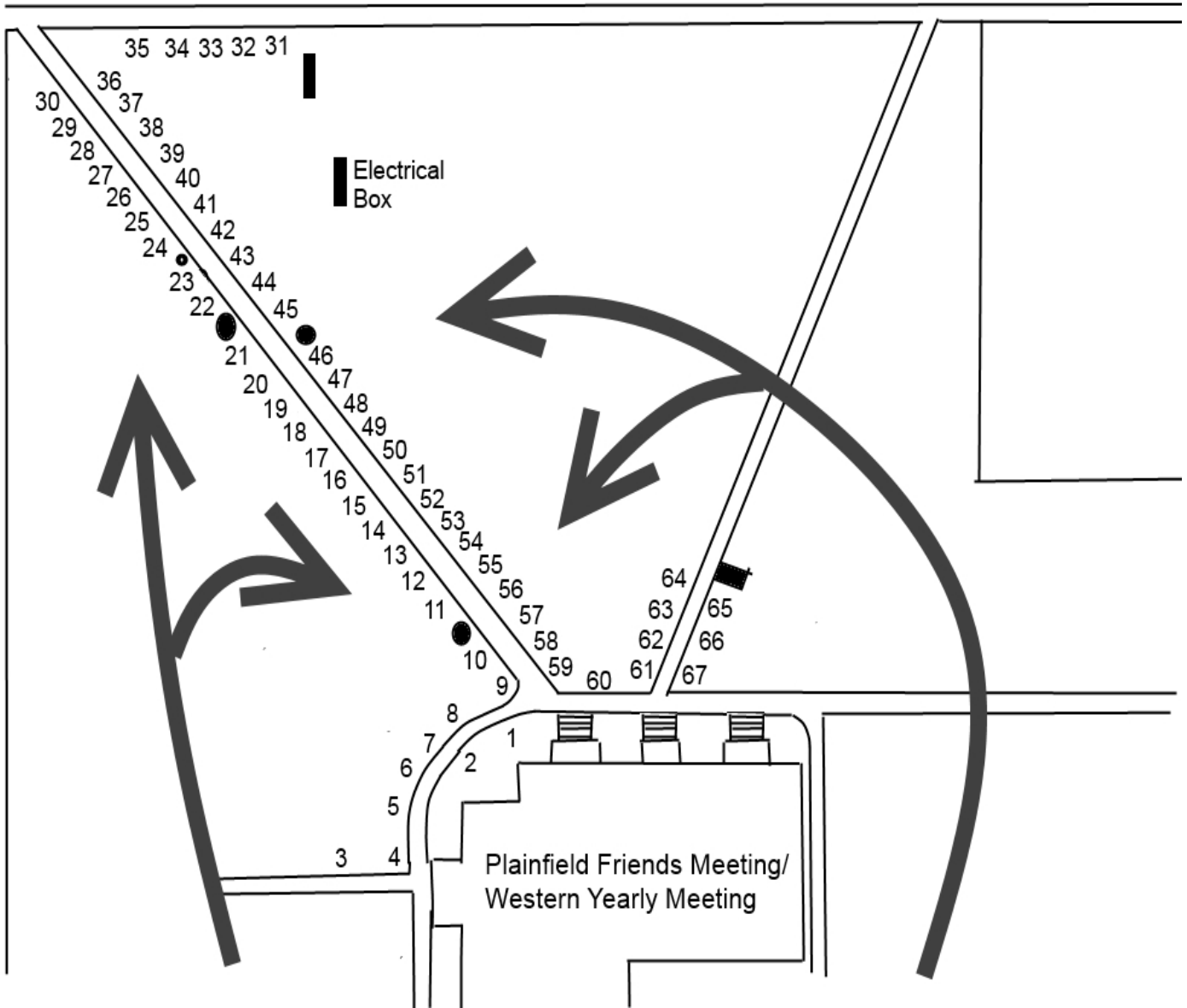
